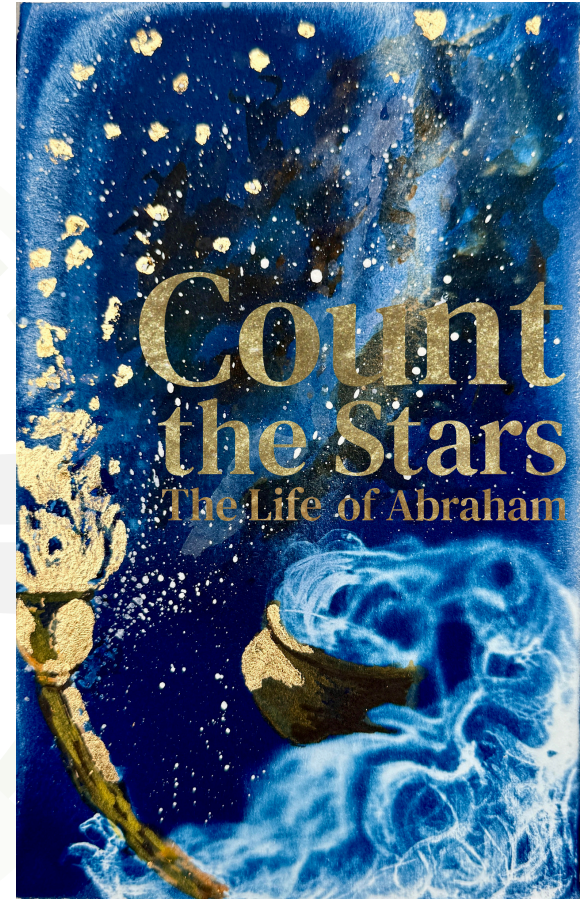

“Oh How Good To Be Together”

Call to Worship | *Isaiah 44:21-28*

Leader: Remember these things, O Jacob, and Israel, for you are my servant. O Israel, you will not be forgotten by me. Return to me, for I have redeemed you.

All: Sing, O heavens, for the Lord has done it; shout, O depths of the earth; break forth into singing, O mountains, O forest and every tree in it! For the Lord has redeemed Jacob and will be glorified in Israel.

Leader: Thus says the Lord, your Redeemer who formed you from the womb: I am the Lord, who made all things, who alone stretched out the heavens, who spread out the earth by myself.

All: The Lord fulfills all his purposes.

Confessing Our Sin

All: Gracious God, you are our Creator and Sustainer. You gave us life and formed us to bear your image. You made us to worship and called us to worship you alone. Nevertheless, O Lord, we regularly exchange your truth for lies and place our faith in false gods. We would determine our own way rather than lean on your wisdom. We would rather be obeyed than obey you. We desire to reign over ourselves rather than submit to your commands. We weary ourselves rather than resting in the flourishing you offer.

O Lord, we repent of our mistrust. Through the power and presence of the Holy Spirit, show us our idolatries and grant us sweet conviction and joyful repentance. Make Christ more beautiful to us than all other things that attempt to captivate our affections. Let us not rest in ourselves but rest fully and completely in you. Renew our wills and strengthen our faith. These prayers we confidently pray in the name of Jesus Christ, our Savior and High Priest. Amen.
